COURSETITLE	CERTIFICATE IN MONTESSORI STUDIES 0-5 or 3-6 YEARS
COURSE DESCRIPTION	The Certificate in Montessori Studies 0-5 Years offers training at a certificate level in Montessori education. It is suitable for assistants, family day care and playgroup leaders. As most childcare environments seldom have children older than 5 years, the 0-5 years focus will generally be the most appropriate. The Certificate in Montessori Studies 3-6 Years is suitable for those employed as teacher assistants in schools or childcare with ages 3-6 years. Ideal for those who hold a CERT III but would like the Montessori curriculum component to assist in a class or centre. This non-award course is appropriate for those working in early childhood environments that do not require a qualification of Diploma or above. Please note, it is not a teaching qualification.
COURSE DELIVERY	The course consists of fourteen workshop days, submission of three sets of curriculum notebook pages, three assignments and completion of three online quizzes. It covers:
