How Can You Help Me? Inclusion Workshop

Montessori Workshop for Educators focusing on Inclusion in the Classroom.

What are the red flags to look for when you are observing children in your classroom? What can these signs indicate and where do you seek help? What can be implemented to help children with learning and behavioural difficulties on their way to normalisation? This is the first of three workshops looking at issues related to the development of movement, sensory integration and language acquisition. Lucette will concentrate on movement based issues and how these affect learning and concentration in children. There will be time in this workshop for discussion about particular problems, how to refer and simple classroom solutions.
