Montessori in Public Schools – A Three Way Partnership – Kay Boulden (Montessori Children's Foundation) and Victoria Marshall-Cerins (Montessori Public Schools Australia, MAF)

Tagai State College and the Torres Strait Islanders Regional Education Council (TSIREC) established a formal learning partnership in 2009 with the Montessori Children's Foundation in order to develop publicly funded Montessori programmes for the children of the Torres Strait. Similar partnerships between MCF and public education and early childhood services are being developed in remote Aboriginal communities seeking better educational experiences for their children.

The Montessori Australia Foundation (MAF) is the peak body supporting Montessori schools and centres in Australia. MAF aims to serve public schools aspiring to develop new Montessori programmes, as an effective pedagogical partner, focused upon supporting the training of local people and establishing robust systems of quality control.

Mitcham Primary School, Mitcham, Victoria is a local public primary school serving around 430 children, and was established in the 1800s. It is located 26km east of Melbourne's city centre.

In 2004, the school commenced a unique learning and teaching initiative offering parents a choice of Montessori education. In 2015, the programme has three Montessori Cycle 2 classes (Grades 1-3) and two Cycle 3 classes (Grades 4-6).

The Montessori classes are co-located with mainstream classes in a new classroom block, with internal flexible learning spaces and classroom access to an outdoor learning area.
