WRITTEN LANGUAGE: THE PREPARATION, PROCESS AND PRODUCT

Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, 16 - 18 March 2015 4:00pm - 7:00pm The Montessori School Kingsley

The hand and mind are the tools needed for clear and beautiful writing. In this workshop we will explore some of the elements of good written work in the 3-6, 6-9 and 9-12 classrooms. We want to auide our students in technical and creative expression - to help them to produce work that is pleasing to the mind and pleasing to the eye.

The Preparation for Writing: Dr. Montessori described the exuberant explosion into writing that was made by children in the first Casa dei Bambini. For the 3-6 child we do not 'teach' writing, but support natural development in such a way that children make the joyful discovery they can 'make their language visible'. We will examine what we have in our Montessori 'toolbox' so as to offer children the assistance they need for this to happen.

The Process of Writing: Clear thinking and clear writing go hand in hand. How do we guide 6-12 students to organise, analyse and synthesise their research? How can we assist them in their "creative" writing.

The Product of Writing: Careful penmanship, decoration, illumination, and illustration contribute to the beautiful finished product of written work. How can we guide and inspire our students to incorporate artistic expression in to their writing projects.

The workshop will include a discussion of "spelling" at all age groups.



J. MCKEEVER is an AMI trainer, examiner and consultant, and the Director of Elementary Training at Montessori Institute of Atlanta, and former Co-Director at Montessori Institute of Milwaukee. She holds diplomas from the Association Montessori Internationale for both the Primary and Elementary Levels, and has spent almost twenty years in Montessori Elementary classrooms.
