

# Montessori Music Workshop

In this 2-hour workshop Susan will share her experiences in music for children from 0-6 years hoping to inspire participants to gain a greater confidence in classroom music: song choices, instrumental choices, music for listening or walking on the line, body percussion, syllabic segmentation, dance and much more.



Susan Chahwan's initial exposure to teaching was Music Education when she studied a Dip.Mus.Ed. (Sydney Conservatorium) As a parent with a passion for Montessori Education, Susan bought a childcare centre and attained a Diploma of Teaching (Early Childhood) and then the AMI 3-6 Diploma in Sydney. After a decade of classroom experience, Susan was mentored by Mrs W. Duyker de Vries who was the founder of the Montessori School in Perth (for children from 3 years to the International Bachelorette). Susan now calls her centres Montessori Works because she firmly believes that Montessori education does work for the sustainable future of all people for a peaceful world.
